SUBJECT: JUNIOR LOG BOOKS Pt2

A bulletin was sent 24 March outlining the requirements around junior log books. This also outlined the issuing of one event licences, which require a log book.

We have noticed an increasing amount of one event licences being issued where the rider has completed kick start, but not yet applied for a log book.

Kick Start books **MUST NOT** be accepted for the issue of a one event competition licence.

Information regarding juniors and one event licences is reproduced below:

All the rules that apply for the issue or renewal of Annual Competition licences apply to the issue of One Event Competition licences

All junior riders **MUST** have been issued a logbook before a One Event Competition licence can be issued. The competency assessment for the capacity bike they will be riding must be entered into the logbook.

If a junior rider does not have a log book with the correct competency they **MUST NOT** be permitted to ride. A Kick Start booklet is **NOT** the same as a logbook. If these are presented then the rider must not be allowed to ride.

Junior riders wishing to ride with One Day Competition licences can be issued a log book by MWA without an annual licence by simply completing the Kick Start coaching and indicating they require a log book only in their application to MWA.

The Motorcycling Western Australia office will issue the rider with a log book, stamped with the issue date.

As a reminder, coaching and log books are not required and do not apply to the issue of Mini, Recreation or One Event Recreation licences.
