

State MX Championship allocation

In the event that more clubs apply to host a round of the State MX Championships than the amount of rounds set by the MX Sporting Panel the following will apply:

1. **In Zone one as per appendix a, one round will be allocated.** This round will consist of a senior and a junior event held on the same weekend which shall not be the first round of the championship and would be given priority for allocation on a long weekend.
2. **In Zone two as per appendix a, two rounds will be allocated.** These rounds will be stand alone events. The allocation of a senior round will not guarantee the allocation of a junior round and vice versa.
3. **In Zone three as per appendix a, three rounds will be allocated.** These rounds will be stand alone events. The allocation of a senior round will not guarantee the allocation of a junior round and vice versa.

The allocation of these rounds from clubs who have applied in the correct manner and submitted their application by the required date to Motorcycling Western Australia will be a simple matter of each zone been drawn from a hat first the first year then on a rotational basis there after.

To alleviate conflict no voting will be conducted in the allocation of rounds.

4. Clubs in Zone one and two who are successful in the allocation for a round will not be entered into the allocation the following year, but will be considered the year after.
5. Should the number of rounds change the MX Sporting Panel will need to review this policy and make the required changes.

Should there not be as many applications in any particular zone but more than six overall then:

- If not enough applications in Zone 2 then the extra events will be allocated to Zone 3.
- If not enough applications in Zone 1 then the extra events will be allocated to Zone 2.
- If not enough applications in Zone 3 then the extra events will be allocated to Zone 1 and 2 depending on the events already allocated in Zone 2.
