SUBJECT: Safety Testing and Supplementary Regulations

As in previous years MWA will be conducting safety testing for illicit drugs and alcohol. This year events we will be targeting will be selected Open and State title, as well as a focus on club level events especially in regional and remote areas.

Please advise your members that even though the event may be low key or remote our testers may very well be on site and will be testing for illicit drugs including recreational and prescription substances that are not permitted in our sport, and alcohol.

Should clubs wish, testing can be performed by the club direct by making their own arrangements with the testing contractors, there is no need to wait for MWA to arrange.

For those clubs wishing to conduct their own testing contact me at the MWA office for details.

All members must be advised that safety testing may be carried out at any time. The preferred method is through supplementary regulations. If your club produces supplementary regulations these must state that safety testing for illicit substances and alcohol may be carried out at this event. For clubs not using formal supplementary regulations members must be advised, for example through their membership sign up, or via newsletter that this safety testing may be carried out at any event.
