SUBJECT: Fire Extinguishers

Motorcycling Western Australia has been working with Motorcycling Australia to clarify a new rule within the Manual of Motorcycle Sport.

Rule 4.2.9.1 d) stipulates: *“Provide 2kg (minimum) dry powder fire extinguishers for immediate use at the Start/Finish line and at officials points. There should also be extinguishers at all refuelling points. Provision of Fire equipment is to be at the satisfaction of the Relevant Controlling Body.”*

Motorcycling Western Australia has been inspecting fire extinguishers as part of our annual venue inspections for some years now and is satisfied that the extinguishers provided at MWA venues are sufficient in number, of the correct type, and tested.

Please take this Bulletin as meeting the requirements of rule 4,2,9,1 d) that the Provision of Fire equipment at venues that have a current Venue Licence have fire equipment to the satisfaction of MWA.

This applies effective immediately.

Motorcycling Western Australia is working towards providing advice to our clubs regards the provision of fire services that meet legislated requirements and Australian Standards for the 2017 season.
