**SUBJECT: *Ridernet* – 24/7 Online Sports Management software UPDATE**

Last year I wrote to you to let you know that soon your club will have an opportunity to share in our new online sports management system *Ridernet*.

While we were working towards having implemented the new system much earlier than now, we are getting very close to going live and expect this to be within the next few weeks.

You may already have noticed the MWA website has been updated to be ready for those changes, including a makeover and provision for riders and clubs to begin to manage their licences, members and events.

While there will be many changes, it is important to let you know about a few things to ensure smooth running of your events.

Firstly, the new system will allow riders to renew licences online. This will generate for many riders an automatic email being sent by the system containing a temporary licence.

Therefore Race Secretaries, and those checking licences need to be aware that riders may be presenting with a new form of valid licence aside from the plastic licence card and the Licence Certificate you may be used to.

Please ensure that all involved in licence checking are informed this new email based licence is accepted at sign on. A licence declaration **does not** need to be completed as the email is a licence. A copy of the email licence is enclosed. Note this is a prototype and may differ slightly in some details in the production system, and may start appearing from early May at events.

We will keep you informed of progress on the implementation of *Ridernet* and how you and your club can take advantage.

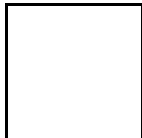

### **Features and Benefits**

**Ridernet** gathers information across the entire organisation providing access to users at all levels (including clubs, riders, coaches and officials) to their data only via a user id and password.

System features include:

#### **Clubs**

- On-line club membership registration.
- Upload manual registrations, upload bulk data
- Accept cash, EFT or cheque payments.
- Weekly payments (from Credit Cards) to your bank account
- Automates the permit application and approval process
- Apply for an event or coaching permit, with automatic approval for many permit types, and automatic emails to appointed officials.
- Event application process automatically provides list of all current officials available to officiate at an event.
- Includes standardised supplementary regulations templates, with much of the content automatically generated, as part of the automated event permitting functions.

### Riders

### Coaches

- Apply for a coaching permit,
- Add rider endorsements and approve riders
- Manage KickStart and competency upgrades for junior riders.
