HIRE OF MWA EQUIPMENT - BY LAW

Adopted: October Council Meeting 1994

Amended: November Council Meeting 2003

The user (club/promoter) shall be fully responsible for the collection, transportation, cleanliness and return of any MWA equipment.

The user (club/promoter) of any MWA equipment shall accept full responsibility for the safe keeping of this equipment during the term of usage and shall accept liability for cleaning, repair or replacement of any damages incurred whatsoever.

Requests for the use of any equipment should be lodged in writing to MWA. Upon collection the equipment must be signed for and recorded in an equipment register.

Any fees determined by the Association for the hire of equipment must be paid upon application.

EQUIPMENT SPECIFICS -

1. AIRFENCE

- a. Hire Charge will be determined annually by the Management Committee and included on the MWA Remittance docket.
- b. The user shall accept full responsibility for this equipment as per the MWA By Law with the exception that a replacement fee will not be applicable if the airfence incurs damage as a result of impact caused by a racing incident.
- c. The user shall provide their own inflationary device.

2. SOUND METERS

- a. A sound meter should be present at all open events.
- b. The user shall accept full responsibility for this equipment as per the MWA By Law.
- c. The sound meters must be recalibrated annually by MWA.

3. HEAD SET RADIOS

- a. It shall be the responsibility of the user to provide the batteries.
- b. The user shall accept full responsibility for this equipment as per the MWA By Law.

4. TRANSPONDERS AND ANCILLIARY EQUIPMENT

- a Hire charge and all other costs shall be determined by Management.
- b Events requiring mandatory use of transponders will be determined by Management.
- c The user shall accept full responsibility for the equipment including the use of all ancillary equipment.
- d The user will be responsible for the return including costs of return for all transponders.
- e The user shall be responsible for returning equipment in a clean state and shall be charged for cleaning should equipment be returned in an unclean condition.
- f Equipment shall be returned in the protective containers as supplied.
