Preface

The MWA State Rider Numbers (SRN) Policy governs the distribution of the following SRN. Riders are allocated SRN for use in MWA permitted events. The ownership of all SRN remains with MWA, and all numbers are allocated in accordance with this policy.

1. ALLOCATION OF SRN (except Trials and Junior Enduro discipline)

- 1.1 SRNs are only available and allocated to riders that obtain an annual Senior/Junior competition licenses (Except for Trials and Junior Enduro).
- 1.2 Numbers are distributed in numerical order and in accordance with the MWA SRN Policy. Riders will be allocated first available number in their chosen discipline; riders will maintain their allocated SRN for as long as their Competition license is valid, and they meet the discipline specific policy as shown below.
- 1.3 Riders have 60-day grace periods from the date of licence expiry date to renew their competition licence and maintain the SRN. After 60 days the SRN will be made inactive in the riders' profile and made available to be allocated to another rider. Riders can choose to relinquish their allocated SRN at which point said number will become available to all MWA members with a valid License.
- 1.4 Riders are prohibited from riding using SRN that is not their allocated SRN.
- 1.5 Riders participating in more than one discipline MUST apply for dedicated discipline SRN.
- 1.6 Riders are prohibited from using a dedicated discipline SRN in another discipline.
- 1.7 Riders signing on or checking into an event with an incorrect SRN or no riding number will be allocated a riding number by the event Race Secretary.
- 1.8 Riders not adhering to the MWA policy may be withdrawn from an event. If a rider is withdrawn from an event, a refund will be at the discretion of the promoter.
- 1.9 It is the responsibility of event Race Secretary to ensure riders use the allocated SRN. SRN will show in Ridernet in the Rider/Class report under the header WA Plate followed by the discipline abbreviation and number.

2. JUNIORS UPGRADING TO A SENIOR COMPETITON LICENCE

Junior riders upgrading their license must be allocated a senior SRN. MWA cannot guarantee the rider will be allocated the same senior SRN as their previous junior SRN.

3. REQUESTING SRN



All SRN requests must be submitted to MWA by submitting a number request form, Form can be found on the MWA website at www.motorcyclingwa.org.au under the Rider header>State Rider numbers tab.

If the SRN is available MWA will allocate the requested number, however, MWA cannot guarantee that requested numbers are available.

4. PLACING NUMBER ON HOLD

SRN will only be placed on hold in the following circumstances:

- 4.1 In the case where a rider elects to use a seeded number for the year, their allocated SRN will not be removed from their profile. Please note seeded numbers will not show on a riders Ridernet profile.
- 4.2 If a rider is injured and is on the current injured riders list.
- 4.3 In the event of fatality during an MWA permitted event, the rider's allocated SRN will be placed on hold for a period of two years, after which, it becomes available to existing MWA members.

5. MOTOCROSS (MX) SRN

Available to riders with a Senior/ Junior National competition licence who participate in the MX discipline. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number. Riders entering Open and State events MUST have a current rider number

Allocated SRN is noted on their Ridernet profile. Riders who do not have an MWA SRN will be assigned a number by the Race Secretary on the day of the event.

5.1 Seeded Numbers

- 5.1.1 MX seeded numbers are 1 to 10.
 - 5.1.2 MX State Championship promoters in consultation with MWA and MX panel will determine on use of seeded numbers in the following year's Championship. Riders should refer to the current year's State Championship Regulations.
 - 5.1.3 Seeded numbers cannot be allocated via Ridernet, Riders Ridernet profile will continue to list the allocated SRN on their profile. Under the Note tab RN profile, a note confirming use of seeded number will be added.
 - 5.1.4 Notification of using seeded number must be sent to MWA in writing prior to the 1st State Championship Round.
- 5.3 **MX Pro A Grade:** For a rider to keep his/or her Pro (A) grade number they must participate in a minimum of 2 Open or State Rounds events in one calendar year, and times must be consistent with the respective grade.
 - 5.4 **MX Expert B Grade:** For a rider to keep his/or her Expert (B) grade number they must participate in a minimum of 2 Open or State Rounds events in one calendar year, and times must be consistent with the respective grade.



- 5.6 **MX Women:** who currently have women dedicated SRN may be required to use MX1 or MX2 plate colours, in this case, women may be required to also apply for a Clubman (C) grade SRN. Refer to the current Motocross Championship regulation to see what plate colours are permitted when participating in MX1 & MX2.

5.7 **MX Two Digit & 3- Digits SRN**

5.7.1 Junior MX riders between 13 to 15 years can request 2-digit SRN, if the requested number is available for allocation the riders must then rescind their 3-digit number to obtain the requested SRN.

5.7.2 Juniors participating in MX3 are permitted to use their Jnr MX SRN.

- 5.8 **Senior/ Junior Plate Colours & Dimensions;** Please refer to the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS)

6. ENDURO (EN) SRN

Available to all riders with a Senior National Competition license who participate in Enduro events. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number. EN numbers are not available to junior competitors.

There two classes in EN, Expert and General. Only riders that compete in the Expert can apply for Expert numbers. All seeded numbers have a letter after the number. (see below). Riders not within the top 5 of these 4 classes, do not need a letter after their number.

6.1 Enduro Seeded Numbers

- 6.1.1 Seeded numbers will be allocated by the Trail and Enduro State Championship Promoter and approved by the Enduro Panel. Seeded numbers cannot be allocated via Ridernet, Riders Ridernet profile will continue to list the allocated SRN on their profile.
- 6.1.2 Riders with seeded numbers are required to run the allocated seeded number for the year when racing in WA State Championship Rounds.
- 6.1.3 If a rider participates or transfers to another Championship or Support class during the season, they are not entitled to use their current seeded number in other classes, riders will be allocated a new number by the Race Secretary.
- 6.1.4 **Expert:** numbers 1 to 10 applicable to top 10 finishers from previous season.
- 6.1.5 **Veterans:** numbers 1 to 5 applicable to top 5 finishers from previous season. Plate colours are black numbers followed by “V” on yellow background.
- 6.1.6 **Masters:** numbers 1 to 5 applicable to top 5 finishers from previous season. Plate colours are white numbers followed by “M” on green background.

- 6.1.7 **Women:** numbers 1 to 5 applicable to top 5 finishers from previous season. Plate colour are white numbers followed by “W” on purple back ground.

7. ROAD RACE (RR) & RR SIDECAR SRN

Available to riders with a Senior National licence. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number.

The competitors who finished 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Superbike, Supersport, Production, and Sidecar Championship classes in the previous year State Road Race Championship may use their seeded numbers of 1, 2, 3 for Superbike, 4,5, 6 for Supersport and 7,8,9 for production.

Racing numbers 1 to 9 are to be reserved for allocation by the Motorcycling WA Road Race Panel in consultation with the Championship Promoter (MCRCWA) with the intent to make these numbers available upon request to Championship placegetters of the previous year.

Any deviation from number/plate regulations must be requested in writing to Motorcycling WA or be stated in the applicable Supplementary Regulations.

- 7.2 **RR Senior/ Junior Plate Colours & Dimensions;** Please refer to the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS)

8. SPEEDWAY & SPEEDWAY SIDE CAR (SP) SRN

Available to riders with a Senior/ Junior National competition licence. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number.

- 8.1 **SP Seeded Numbers:** 1- 3 are seeded numbers and are allocated at the discretion of the promoter.
- 8.2 **RRSC Senior/ Junior Plate Colours & Dimensions;** Please refer to the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS)

9. TRIALS (TR) SRN

Trials discipline is not allocated MWA SRN, numbers are allocated at events by the Race Secretary.

10. HISTORIC ROAD RACE (HRR) & HISTORIC ROAD RACE SIDECAR SRN



Available to riders with a Senior National licence. There are no seeded numbers for this discipline. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number.

10.1 **HRR & SC Senior/ Junior Plate Colours & Dimensions; Please** refer to the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS)

11. SUPERMOTO (SM) SRN

Available to riders with a Senior National licence. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number. There are no seeded numbers for this discipline.

11.1 SM Senior/ Junior Plate Colours & Dimensions

Please refer to the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport (MoMS)

12. ALL TERRIAN VEHICLE (ATV) SRN

Available to riders with a Senior National licence. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number. If an SRN request has not been submitted to MWA, riders will be allocated the lowest available number. There are no seeded numbers for this discipline.
