5.1 Selling of Maylands Building:

- MWA has been approached by a developer looking to purchase the entire complex for the development of units.
 - All tenants have shown interest in the sale of the complex
 - Developer has suggested a purchase price of \$680,000.00 in hand which is above the auditor evaluation of \$550,000.00.

The positives to selling 25/168 Guildford Road, Maylands

- Projected saving, if premises are sold will be minimum of \$16,000.00 to \$17,000.00 per annum in strata title fees.
- MWA could rent or purchase a property with storage facility as currently the office does not have storage space needed by MWA.
- Possibility of sharing office space with another organization and dividing the cost of the amenities reducing MWA annual expenditure.
- Selling to developers would mean no commission to pay, no advertising costs and quicker turn over if offer is accepted.

The areas for relocation being looked at are Embleton/Bayswater Area.

- **Barbagallo** Minister Murray assisted MCRC with the government financial aid to return bikes back to Barbagallo.
